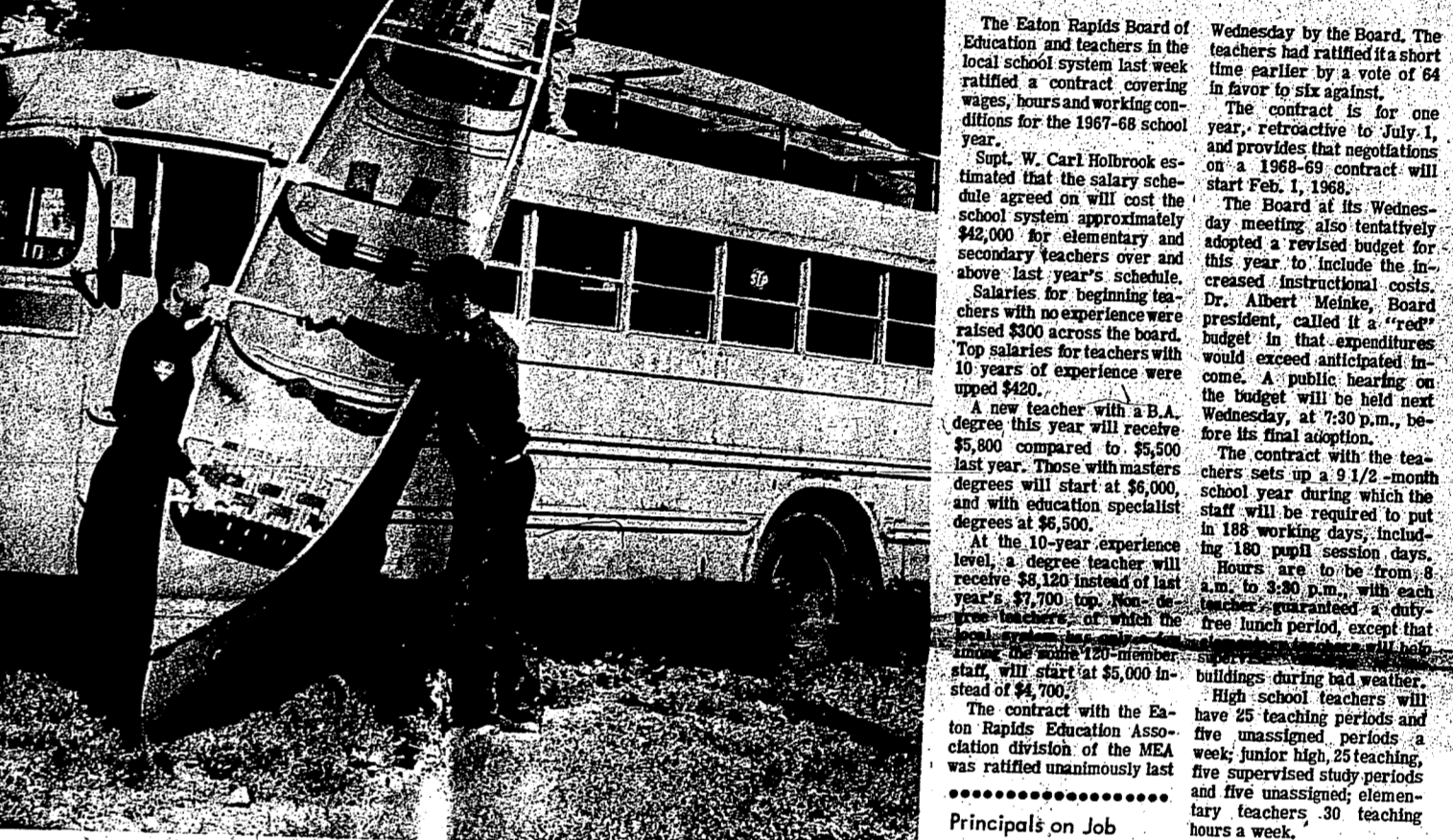
City Wins Award for Car Check. Eaton Rapids placed among the top small cities in the United States in the 1967 National Vehicle Safety Check contest.
