In the Matter of the Petition of Vernon J. Brown, Auditor General of the State of Michigan, for and in behalf of said State, for the sale of certain lands for taxes assessed thereon.

To the Circuit Court for the County of Eaton in Chancery: Vernon J. Brown, Auditor General of the State of Michigan, respectfully sheweth unto the Court that he is the Auditor General of the State of Michigan and makes and files this petition under, by virtue of and pursuant to the provisions of Act No. 208 of the Public Acts of 1930, as amended, and Act No. 126 of the Public Acts of 1935, as amended;

That Schedule A annexed hereto is the tax record required by the act first above mentioned and contains the description of all lands in the said county upon which taxes, which were assessed for the years mentioned therein, have remained unpaid for more than one year after they were returned as delinquent, the description of all lands in said county heretofore bid off in the name of the State and thus held and upon which taxes which were assessed subsequent to the tax for which such lands were sold to the State have remained unpaid for more than one year after they were returned as delinquent, and the description of all lands in said county which are delinquent for any installment of taxes under the provisions of the act last above mentioned;

and against which extended in favor of the people of the State of Michigan, the payment of which this court may enforce as a preferred or first claim upon such lands by the sale thereof.

Wherefore your petitioner prays: a. That within the time provided by law, this court may determine and decree that the aforesaid taxes, interest, collection fee and charges are valid and constitute a valid lien upon each of the said several parcels of land described in said schedule as therein extended;
